

## Privacy information

The Bank of England (the “Bank”) in its capacity as Chair, administrator and secretariat of the Foreign Exchange Joint Standing Committee (the “Committee”) and administrator and secretariat of sub-committees of the Committee, may collect the name, work email address, job title, name of organisation, and summary of role and experience, from individuals who submit an application for membership of the Committee or of a sub-committee. The Bank may also collect certain of this information from individuals or organisations who nominate an individual for membership of the Committee or a sub-committee.

Each member of the Committee or a sub-committee and the Bank may also collect views, opinions and further personal data where this is shared either verbally or in writing (e.g. by using an online ‘chat’ function) by individuals participating in meetings for the Committee or sub-committee.

The Bank is likely to be a ‘controller’ (within the meaning of data protection law) in respect of the personal data it processes for the selection of members and (where applicable) the chairing and administration of committee meetings.

The Bank also considers that each member of the Committee or a sub-committee is likely to be a ‘controller’ in respect of their own processing of personal data for the purposes of their participation in the relevant committee.

Where the Bank processes personal data for the purposes of the Committee or any sub-committee, it will use the information for the purpose of reviewing applications for membership of the committee, to communicate with members of the committee and to advance the purposes of the committee as set out more fully in the terms of reference applicable to the committee.

The Bank will process personal data where necessary for the performance of its tasks carried out in the public interest being the establishment of a senior-level forum for market participants and infrastructure providers active in the UK and the relevant UK public authorities to meet regularly to discuss conjunctural and structural issues concerning the wholesale foreign exchange market and the associated supporting infrastructure.

To ensure that the Bank’s external engagement on these issues is transparent, the names of Committee and sub-committee members and their affiliated organisation, may be published on the Bank’s website.
