Let's see how well you know London! If you need help, ask a sibling or adult!

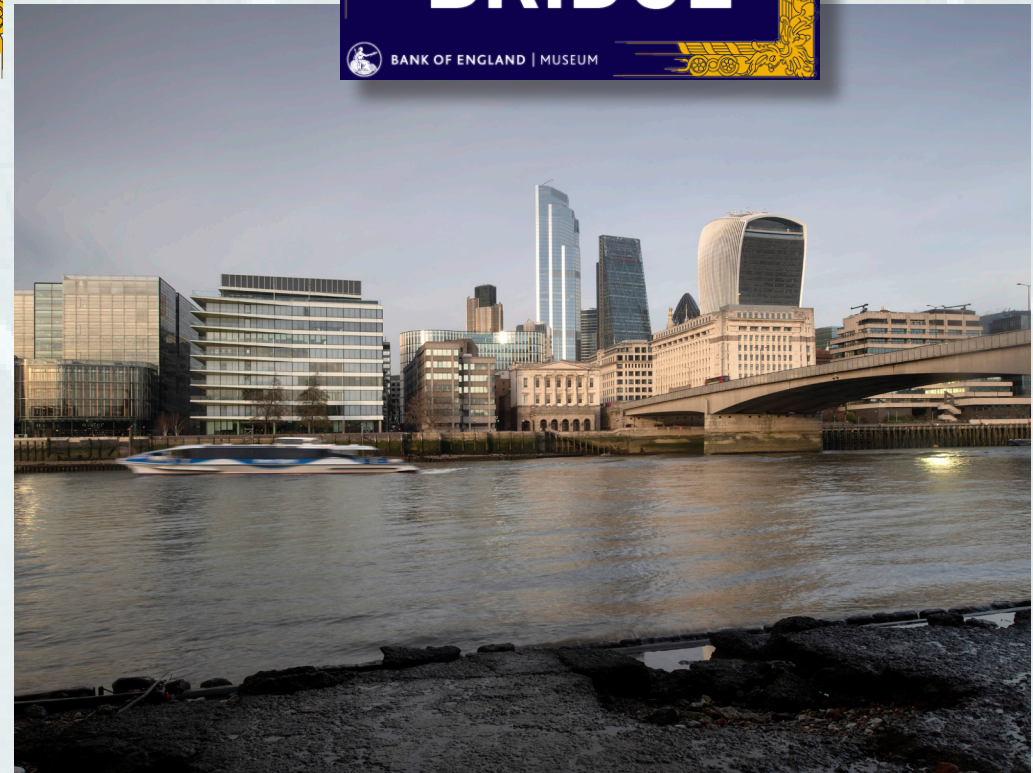




What's the name of this famous London river?

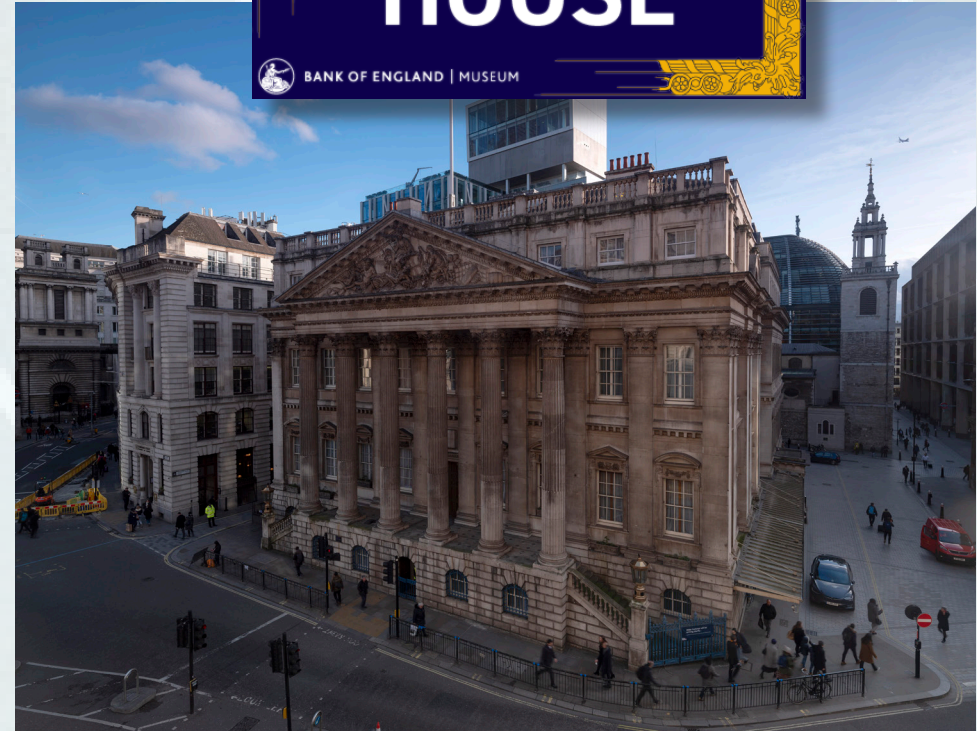
How many boats can you see on the river right now?
