ACTION

- (1) In accordance with Article 26(3), first subparagraph, of Regulation 575/2013 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 26th June 2013 on prudential requirements for credit institutions and investment firms (as it forms part of Retained EU Law) (the "CRR"), the Prudential Regulation Authority ("the PRA") has decided to grant the company the permission on a consolidated basis to classify 69,186,004 new ordinary shares, each with a nominal value of US\$0.50, and representing, in aggregate, approximately \$34.6 million in share capital, which were issued by Standard Chartered plc on 10 May 2015; and any future issuances of shares that satisfy the conditions in the second paragraph of Article 26(3) CRR, as common equity tier 1 instruments.
- (2) This permission is granted pursuant to Article 26(3) of the CRR, on the basis that the criteria set out in Article 28 or, where applicable, Article 29, of the CRR have been met and continue to be met. The PRA reserves the right to evaluate the instrument at any time which may result in the revocation of this permission in whole or in part.
